This conference is an opportunity to bring our heads together to define our ambitions and priorities and build the foundations for a community-led Place Plan for Leith.

Over the next 12 months, with the support of the Scottish Community Development Centre, together we can build on the decisions and commitments we make at this conference and develop the support structures we need to deliver.
